





Context and Business Challenge

In May 2023, the German group Talanx—controller of HDI International to which HDI Seguros belongs—announced the acquisition of Liberty Mutual's operations in Latin America (Chile, Brazil, Colombia, and Ecuador).

For **HDI Seguros**, this represented a regional technology challenge: migrate the entirety of systems to AWS's enterprise cloud on a tight timeline while maintaining business continuity.

At the start of 2024, **HDI Seguros Chile** reached a strategic agreement with In Motion (www.grupoinmotion.com)—a multinational leader in digital transformation for insurance carriers with specialized products and services across all cloud layers (SaaS, IaaS, multi-line Insurance Core for Life, Personal Accident, Health, P&C, Auto; digital customer care; omnichannel, and more).

Scope and Execution

The challenge: plan and execute a Lift-and-Shift migration—from on-premises environments to the cloud—of core and satellite systems to AWS under **HDI Seguros Chile's** control and policies, in approximately ten months.

In practice, the project migrated 100% of IT platforms, 120 Power BI dashboards, 97 applications, over 400 SharePoints, more than 100 shared inboxes, and seven platforms, and created 118 automated processes.
